StudentsLive, A Global Arts Education Company and Passport to Broadway International are continuing our partnership with the **Bakti Budaya Djarum Foundation** of Indonesia that exists “to bring Indonesia forward by increasing the quality of its human resources and maintain the sustainability of its natural resources”. **StudentsLive and Bakti Budaya Djarum Foundation** are announcing we have just finalized a partnership through 2022 we will be providing online curriculum for actors and artists in Indonesia, professional development for teachers and will be returning to Jakarta for our second workshop in Indonesia in Summer 2022. Select students will be chosen from the Summer 2022 workshop to travel to New York in Winter 2022 for an Advanced Program studying under our artistic direction with a select team of Broadway Artists Faculty and Professionals.

The online courses will be available in 2021 via the Djarum Foundation and StudentsLive platforms (to be announced) for beginning, intermediate and advanced level students in performance arts and will tie into other programs StudentsLive is producing as a part of our intensive longer-term training in Theater Arts. The 2021 online curriculum will be part of the advanced placement assessment for an opportunity to audition for the Summer 2022 program. StudentsLive, as always, will hold our students to the highest standards of commitment, dedication and training to participate. Our mutual long-term goal is to develop outstanding Musical Theater Performance skills for students and artists in Indonesia in order to increase their skill sets in local Indonesian shows and cultural performances as well as to increase their access to opportunities on Broadway and regional theater in the United States.
